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Bad Waldsee (bis 1956 *Waldsee*) ist eine **baden-württembergische Große Kreisstadt** in **Oberschwaben** im **Landkreis Ravensburg** mit 20.630 Einwohnern. Was wird erhoben?

In vielen deutschsprachigen Gebieten, vor allem in Norddeutschland, werden die traditionellen Dialekte nur noch von älteren Sprecherinnen und Sprechern verwendet, in anderen Regionen, z. B. dem Ruhrgebiet, sind sie fast vollständig aus dem Sprachgebrauch verschwunden. Regionale Unterschiede haben sich aber bis in die Standardsprache, das "Hochdeutsche", erhalten. Das betrifft lautliche Merkmale, besonders aber den Wortschatz. So sind im Hochdeutschen sowohl das eher im Nord(ost)en gebrauchte *Sonnabend* wie auch das eher in der Mitte und im Süden bevorzugte *Samstag* zugelassen (siehe '[Pilotprojekt](#)', Karte *Samstag/Sonnabend*). Besonders deutliche regionale Unterschiede weist die Alltagssprache auf. Für den 'Atlas zur deutschen Alltagssprache' werden neben regionalen Varianten des Wortschatzes auch solche zur Aussprache, zu den grammatischen Formen oder auch zu Formen der Anrede erhoben.

Wieso und wozu?

Lebendige Sprachen wie das Deutsche befinden sich in ständigem Wandel. Mit dem Projekt "Atlas zur deutschen Alltagssprache" soll zum einen die aktuelle Vielfalt des Deutschen erfasst und anschaulich auf Karten dargestellt werden; die Art der Datenerhebung und Kartierung schließt damit an den "Wortatlas der deutschen Umgangssprachen" von Jürgen Eichhoff an, der von 1977-2000 in vier Bänden erschien (und einen Ergänzungsband von Peter H. Nelde zu den "deutschen Umgangssprachen in Belgien" aus dem Jahr 1987). Durch den Vergleich der alten mit den entsprechenden neuen Sprachkarten aus der gegenwärtigen Interneterhebung können zum anderen Veränderungen des Sprachgebrauchs in den letzten 40-50 Jahren nachvollzogen werden. Die Daten schaffen damit die Grundlage für Aussagen zur aktuellen Variation wie auch zu Entwicklungstendenzen des Deutschen.

Wie wird erhoben?

Die verschiedenen regionalen Varianten werden über Internetumfragen, also per indirekter Methode, an zahlreichen Orten im deutschsprachigen Raum

- 2-3/4 cups all-purpose flour
- 1 pinch salt
- 5 eggs

Rote Grütze mit Vanillesoße

In recent decades, this pudding went from an old-fashioned dessert to a culinary blockbuster. Although recipes vary greatly, almost all of them call for red currants, which are much more popular in Germany than in North America, where they can be difficult to find. The other fruits - raspberries, cherries, blackberries, strawberries, or blueberries - depend on the individual taste, but there is one rule of thumb: you should include at least one tart fruit. There are also several ways to top Rote Grütze: with vanilla sauce, whipped cream, cream, vanilla ice cream, cream of wheat/semolina pudding or just milk.

AnnenMayKantereit. Even if this band name sounds a bit complicated at first, it's actually really easy to explain its source: The pseudonym of these three musicians from Cologne results from putting the three band members' names together - Christopher ANNEN plays the guitar and harmonica, Henning MAY sings and plays the piano and Severin KANTEREIT sits at the drum kit.

But AnnenMayKantereit have much more to offer than just an unusual band name. They formed in 2011 shortly after finishing high school together and in these first years primarily made one thing: street music. This experience impacted the trio so deeply that in 2013 they recorded and produced their first album, *AnnenMayKantereit*, single-handedly, not in a recording studio, but outside, in the open. The reason? AnnenMayKantereit wanted to capture their "street sound" as much as possible on the recording. "It was really important for us to record outside, because we always played outside. It was really nice to record the album while looking up at the sky."

The band acquired Germany-wide fame with its first single, *Wohin du gehst* (Wherever you go), in 2014. A club tour around Germany was followed by a summer packed with music festivals and a fall where
